

Lawrence Schools Foundation PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT & LEARNING GRANT

Purpose of the program

This Professional Development Grant was established through the Lawrence Schools Foundation, to provide professional learning opportunities and summer professional learning compensation to facilitate responses content area learning standards, for Lawrence Public Schools educators of grades 9-12.

Grant amounts and Funding Priorities

Specific priorities include demonstration of potential impact of Professional Development to support teaching and learning in the following areas:

FOR TEACHERS AND STUDENTS IN INCLUSIVE CONTENT AREAS

- 1. Required: Professional Development in inclusive content area classes across grades and disciplines.
- 2. Preferred: for teachers of science, social studies, math, literature (as opposed to reading, writing, coaching, behavioral management, classroom management, etc.)

IN GRADES 9-12

- 1. Required: For teachers of students in grades 9-12.
- 2. Preferred: focus on vertical scope and sequence in a content area or cross-curricular uses of the PD in the different content areas.

RESPONSIVE TO HIGHER ORDER THINKING STANDARDS:

- 1. Required: Demonstration of Professional Development alignment with standards for incorporating higher order thinking and reasoning into required curricula.
- 2. Preferred: teaching and learning associated with explaining main ideas and themes, tracing causes and effects, comparing and contrasting and analyzing argumentation (as opposed to facts, details, outlining, etc.)

All grants are subject to the final approval of the Foundation Board of Trustees and the superintendent.

Eligibility

Priority will be given to applications that are well aligned to district and building goals, have secured facilitators, and can articulate their expected outcomes for participants and students.

Review Committee

The Foundation Board of Trustees and the district's Curriculum, and Instruction Administrative Team will have final approval of grants to be awarded.
